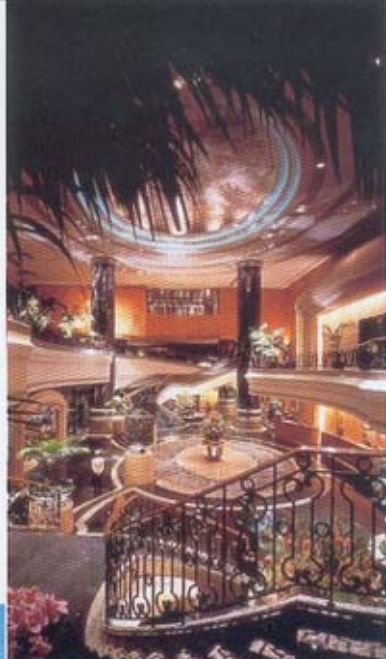


Luxurious and stylish haven for business travellers

This impression is further enhanced by the fabulous marbled bathroom, which in itself is not only huge but the oversize Jacuzzi is large enough to have



a party in it. When one thinks they have seen everything, the final surprise is the second bedroom and bathroom. There is more than sufficient area and facilities for a couple to really indulge or several persons to have a relaxed, enjoyable and memorable weekend.

It is understandable why such famous persons as former President Clinton, Ted Turner, Karl Lagerfeld, Mariah Carey, Luciano Pavarotti, Cindy Crawford, Bruce Willis and Prince Albert of Monaco chose this suite for their stay — just a few of the many.

The *Presidential Suite* is part of the upper floors, which form the elite *Regency Club*. Major features include a luxurious and spectacular split-level lounge with panoramic views of Victoria Harbour, beverages and snacks throughout the day, library, four function rooms and a private office with secretarial services. This well designed and laid out area with the furniture styles in earthy tones and balance of wood, leather and marble complements the Art Deco style of the hotel.

Guests may also enjoy the hotel's extensive and fully complete fitness centre, tennis courts, golf driving range and Hong Kong's largest freeform hotel swimming pool, located on a spacious beautifully landscaped podium.

For exceptional dining or simply a relaxed chat over drinks with friends and colleagues, the Grand Hyatt stands tall in this area also with five restaurants, two lounges and one of the hottest nightspots in Hong Kong.

There are many restaurants in Hong Kong with great harbour views, but *One Harbour Road* stands above the rest. With its split-level design, every diner has a spectacular view of Victoria Harbour. Fashioned after a taipan's elegant Peak mansion during the 1930's, *One Harbour Road* brings up memories of scenes from the movie 'Taipan'. The cuisine is Cantonese at its home-style best. According to Chef Li Shu-Tim, Chef de Cuisine-Chinese, "No foreign influences, and no nouvelle nuances – just traditional dishes lovingly prepared and graciously presented."

Award-winning Grissini, named after the popular Italian breadstick, specialises in authentic Northern Italian cuisine. With a great panoramic view of Victoria Harbour in a contemporary décor and avant-garde furnishings, it is a reminder of a stylish New York restaurant. Upon entering *Grissini*, one is greeted by a large baking oven where fresh breadsticks are being prepared and an absolutely delightful aroma is filling the restaurant.

To finish off the night with a celebration of cocktails and possibly more, the Parisian-style *Champagne Bar*, boasting the most extensive champagne list in town, is not to be missed.

For a more casual evening, one can venture into JJ's, a split-level multi-entertainment centre with a variety of exciting as well as relaxing activities — something for everyone.
